

Outstation, Emergency and Non- Allopathic Treatment Procedures

Availing Emergency, Outstation (Non-CHSS Areas) and Non-Allopathic Treatments		
1.	Ayurvedic and Homeopathy Treatment for Retirees	<p>Treatment to be taken from empanelled AMAs only for which notification is issued by BARC from time to time.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Application to be submitted in the prescribed form to the unit from which the beneficiary has retired from. ➤ Copy of the CHSS card of the patient to be enclosed. ➤ Scanned copies can be sent either through mail or through post. ➤ Those retired from BARC may send the application to DEO (pension) (deopension@barc.gov.in), mail address to be indicated. Permission letter will be sent through email or by post. ➤ Validity of the referral note will be for 90 days, ➤ First consultation to be done within this validity period ➤ Maximum 4 consultations are allowed. ➤ During this period, no allopathic treatment is permitted for the same disease. ➤ The cost of the treatment will be initially borne by the beneficiary. ➤ Claim for reimbursement may be submitted in the prescribed form to the Accounts Officer of the respective unit after the four consultations ➤ Claim will be settled as per the provisions of CSMA rules ➤ https://dae.gov.in/writereaddata/chss06012020.pdf ➤ (BARC OM dated 9/12/2020 *18/3/2021)

Yoga and Naturopathy Treatments for the retired	<p>Procedure to avail Yoga and Naturopathy under CHSS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Treatment to be availed from Empanelled AYUSH hospitals/Centres under the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare ➤ Reference will be given by Head of Office from which retired based on the request made by the Beneficiary ➤ Copy of CHSS card to be attached.

	Continuation of Yoga and Naturopathy Treatments for the retired	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ CHSS card of the beneficiary requiring treatment to be produced at the time of OPD/Indoor treatment ➤ Cost will be borne by the individual and can claim reimbursement ➤ No TA/DA ➤ Reimbursement will be as per the notified rates of Ministry of Health ➤ https://dae.gov.in/writereaddata/chss05122018.pdf

Emergency Treatment / admission	<p style="text-align: center;">In Case Treatment taken Outside Mumbai</p> <p>Inform the dispensary concerned within 4 days from the date of admission</p> <p>Claim to be submitted in form 97 A</p> <p>The form supported with all the necessary bills etc., to be submitted to the Accounts Officer of the unit concerned</p> <p>Claim will be settled under CSMA Rules</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Within Mumbai in Empanelled Hospitals</p> <p>Inform the Dispensary/Hospital within four days</p> <p>Try to get referral from Hospital immediately on admission, in which case for admissible items beneficiary need not pay</p> <p style="text-align: center;">OR</p> <p>Bear the expenditure and claim reimbursement under LES form</p> <p>Form to be submitted to APO, CHSS Division for reimbursement</p> <p>Claim settled based on the recommendation of the committee constituted for the purpose</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Within Mumbai in other than empanelled hospital</p> <p>Inform the Dispensary/Hospital within four days</p> <p style="text-align: center;">OR</p> <p>Bear the expenditure and claim reimbursement under LES form</p> <p>Form to be submitted to APO, CHSS Division for reimbursement</p>

		Claim settled based on the recommendation of the committee constituted for the purpose
4.	Retirees who have opted for CHSS but settled in a place where CHSS scheme is not in operation	<p>Hospitalisation: Beneficiaries can come to Mumbai for in- house treatment at BARC Hospital.</p> <p>(or) They have an option to claim for reimbursement following the pattern of CS (MA) Rules. <i>Such reimbursement shall be allowed only for the treatment availed of through the following –</i></p> <p>(a) Government hospitals and medical institution of the local authorities such as District Hospitals, Medical colleges, Municipal Hospital, etc.</p> <p>(b) Private Hospitals as recognised by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, New Delhi.</p> <p>(c) Hospitals recognized under CGHS.</p> <p>(d) Hospitals recognized by the concerned State Government, other Central Government Departments and Public Sector Undertakings under the control of DAE.</p> <p>Treatment in OPD: Reimbursement cost towards such treatment will be as per CGHS rates or actual whichever is less.</p> <p>https://dae.gov.in/writereaddata/chss05122018_3.pdf</p>
